Hello Danville family,

It is amazing how fast the days go by once school starts. The Danville Elementary PTA would like to help you prepare for the holiday season. We are working with UnitedScrip in order to provide you with a way to order gift cards in a fast and easy manner. The fund-raising program will provide a percentage of every purchase to the Danville PTA. It will not cost you additional dollars unless you opt for the direct shipping method or a bank draft payment option.
There is no selling, just focused spending.

Each year the Danville PTA reviews possible fundraisers in order to continue the programs and services provided to the children at Danville Elementary School. By combining our spending dollars and working together through the Scrip Program, we can create a powerful source of revenue for our 2011-2012 school year.

Do you have a hard time picking out gifts for family members or friends? **Well, look no further.** A gift card is a wonderful option for teenagers, grandparents, and everyone in between.

How does this fund-raiser work? **Each vendor has designated a certain percentage of the purchase that will be given back to the Danville Elementary PTA.**

Where do you begin? Review the attached vendor list and order form, crosscheck your gift list, and register as a new user and order from the convenience of your home. **That's right! No lines, no waiting, and you won't have to circle store lots for a parking spot.** You have a few purchase and delivery options:

- ❖ **Shop:** Go on-line at www.scripzone.com. Log-in and set up an account.
- ❖ Select **GROUP ID: 603974DE**

- ❖ **Personal Check Order:** At payment option, confirm your order and an email will be sent to you and the Danville PTA Contact. **Send your personal check written out to: Danville PTA** in an envelope marked: Danville PTA Scrip and place in your Danville Delivery folder. Once the PTA Contact has received and deposited your check, then the on-line order will be processed.

- ❖ **On-Line Payment Order Options:** credit card or Direct Automated Clearing House Payment via ScripPayment Gateway (with a \$.50 transaction fee paid by purchaser for their bank electronic transfer).

**** ALL orders, paper and on-line, are due by: Friday, December 9th** in order to properly deliver the gift cards before the holidays. On-line orders will be canceled if payment is not received before the due date.

- ❖ **Delivery Options:** If you opt for direct shipping to your home, there is a shipping fee to be paid by you. In order to take advantage of **FREE** shipping, select shipping to our group, Danville PTA. Parent/Customer **PICK UP ON: Friday, December 16th from 4-6 pm at the Danville Elementary School.** OR contact the PTA's Scrip Coordinator and set up a delivery date.

Once the holidays are over the ScripZone fund-raising program will continue for Danville Elementary PTA. We will forward orders on a monthly basis, so keep the program in mind for all of your monthly or special purchases (groceries, gas, birthdays, grandparents' day, etc.) throughout the year. If just 50 families in our school purchased \$200 in Scrip each month for groceries x 6 months, the Danville Elementary PTA would profit \$2,400 (if the grocery store's percentage was 4% for example). That is just in 6 months of groceries! Pure profit from a program that asks only for us to think ahead, purchase gift cards (Scrip) and use it like cash, check, or charge for our normal spending.

Please join us and enjoy the holiday season by spending more time with family and less time standing in shopping checkout lines and running around between various store locations.
